Twelfth Night was originally broadcast by National Theatre Live in 2017. Shakespeare's classic comedy of mistaken identity was a hit at the National Theatre. This joyous production is directed by Simon Godwin with Tamsin Greig as a transformed Malvolia.

A ship is wrecked on the rocks. Viola is washed ashore but her twin brother Sebastian is lost. Determined to survive on her own, she steps out to explore a new land. So begins a whirlwind of mistaken

identity and unrequited love. The nearby households of Olivia and Orsino are overrun with passion. Even Olivia's upright housekeeper Malvolia is swept up in the madness. Where music is the food of love, and nobody is quite what they seem, anything proves possible.
