As a reflection of the enormous popularity of NT Live, and in response to the increasing challenges facing school budgets, in 2015 we launched On Demand In Schools, a ground-breaking service designed to give schools a way of streaming our productions directly to classrooms. Sixty-four percent of all secondary schools in the UK have already signed up to use this service, which is accompanied by a wide range of free learning resources making it easier than ever for teachers to share world-class drama with thousands of young people across the country.

Now we have found a way to take this even further.

This month, we launch **National Theatre Collection**, a new streaming service that draws on 10 years of NT Live broadcasts, as well as high-quality recordings never previously seen outside of the NT's Archive. This project will make the best of British theatre available to libraries, schools, universities and the wider education sector, worldwide.

With your help, we hope to expand the range of productions available via this platform from 19 to 30, bringing more great theatre to students around the world. More importantly, your support will make it possible for us to continue offering our productions to all state-funded schools in the UK for free, ensuring that drama is a part of every child's education.
